The Engineering, Mechanics & Experience of Moving the Pallesen

The process of moving a 2-story, 4-unit, 5,000 sq. ft, National Landmark-eligible, 110-year-old, wood-framed building is not a job for rookies. Habitat for Humanity has hired industry veteran Jim Salata's Garden City Construction to manage this project team, which includes experts in moving buildings (Kelly Brothers House Movers), and experts in the temporary clearing of street lights and traffic signals that would otherwise obstruct the path of a massive building not designed to transit city streets, and their control boxes (Baer Electric).

PAC* SJ has prepared a short video that provides a little behind-the-scenes information on how this historic building will be moved, and the people behind that work.
